#### New Matrix Feature: Media Privacy Launching December 9

Matrix is introducing a new **Media Privacy** tool designed to support homeowner privacy by allowing agents to manage which listing media remains visible after a property is off-market. This enhancement applies to both **listing photos and supplements** stored in Matrix.

#### □ Photos

Agents will now have an optional setting that allows them to:

- Designate **one "permanent" photo** to remain public after closing.
- Mark additional photos as private once the listing is off-market, if desired.
- Leave all photos public if no changes are made the system will continue to function as it does today.

- ☐ If an agent chooses to designate only one permanent photo, it must still comply with existing photo requirements:
  - Residential & Multi-Family: the permanent photo must be an exterior elevation image of the property.
  - Vacant Land: the permanent photo must be an actual photo of the parcel **not** a GIS image, aerial outline, plat, or map graphic.

**Important**: Even when photos are marked private, **MLS users will still have access** to them. The setting only affects **public display**, including consumer-facing portals and IDX feeds.

#### ☐ Supplements / Documents

Media Privacy also extends to listing supplements, allowing agents to classify each document as:

- Public visible to consumers (e.g., OneHome/Client Portal).
- Private visible only to MLS users
- Conditional public while active, automatically private once off-market

As with photos, marking supplements as Private or Conditional does not remove MLS user access; it only restricts public-facing display. Agents may adjust these settings at any time.

#### **Tax Increment Financing (TIF)**

Tax Increment Financing (TIF) is being used by cities across the U.S. to fund affordable housing, downtown revitalization, transit, and walkable urban development, with notable successes in places like Muskegon, Milwaukee, Carmel, and Washington, D.C.. While TIF can spur economic growth and community improvements, its use for large-scale projects like data centers has drawn criticism for potential risks, lack of transparency, and questionable public benefit. When applied responsibly, TIF and related value capture tools can transform blighted areas, support mixed-use development, and generate lasting fiscal benefits for municipalities.


