

EXTERIOR ELEVATION

As used in these Rules and Regulations, “Exterior Elevation” refers to the straight-on view of the home’s exterior. The view should capture home features, such as an entry door(s), window(s), yard, porch or deck (if any) and other details visible from the straight-on exterior view of the home. The photograph should capture the home’s exterior from the point of view of the average person standing in front of the house, looking straight on, but far enough back to see the entire home (for example, 🏠).
