Buyer Agency? Tenant Representation?Why not both?

A potential buyer contacts an agent and is looking for a home to purchase in the area. The agent explains that the residential market is quite competitive right now and that some buyers are having a challenging time getting an accepted offer on a property. The potential buyer is moving for work and would prefer to purchase a home but ultimately needs a place to live in the area and will consider renting. The

potential buyer will be in town for one week and has asked the agent to set up showings for homes fitting the potential buyer's specifications but also asks the agent to set up showings for rental properties as a backup. The agent wants to make sure she gets paid for her work whether the buyer ends up purchasing or renting a home. How should the agent proceed?

Many agents are familiar with using the WB-36 Buyer Agency/Tenant Representation Agreement to work as a buyer's agent for a client who is looking to purchase a home. This versatile form, however, also includes provisions for an agent to work as a tenant representative for a person who is looking for a rental property.







RPAC REPORT Legislative Updates

THE CHAIR CHAPTER 5

The Chair.

Besides the obvious usage for sitting, The Chair has a different meaning altogether when it comes to real estate. The Chair symbolizes a seat at the table for a REALTOR®, GAD or lobbyist when legislation that will affect housing, land use and the rights of private property owners are discussed, or local ordinances regarding zoning and land use are planned.

The Chair means that your business interests are being represented, policies that make it easier for your customers to achieve the dream of homeownership are realized and that bills that are an impediment to housing are defeated. In short, we have a seat at the table.

<u>Because we had a seat at the table</u>, property taxes in Wisconsin will decrease by \$650 million, broadband will expand by a combined \$225 million, technology at DSPS will be upgraded to simplify online credentialing, owners of waterfront properties had their riparian rights restored to place a pier and your industry was deemed an essential business at the start of the COVID-19 pandemic.



To have a meaningful dialogue with our elected representatives, we need to support them. How? Through the three principals of the REALTOR® Party: Vote, Act, Invest. First, vote for REALTOR® champions at all levels of governance. Next, act by attending REALTOR® & Government Day February 9th in Madison and last, invest in Direct Giver.

If you have made an investment in Direct Giver this year, please accept our thanks, if not now is the time to do so. Direct Giver is a minimum investment of \$100 up to \$1000 that goes to support local, state, and federal candidates that support your industry. It does not buy votes.
